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Course Description

Students will focus on improving their literacy through intercultural studies. They will complete structured reading, writing and research tasks to develop their knowledge of French culture and language. They will complete a film study as a part of their assessment work.

Learning Outcomes

Listens appropriately to differing viewpoints on social and cultural situations
Writes well-structured sentences and paragraphs

Materials Required

Typical Homework/ Assignments/ Late Work Policy
