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
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Outdoor Education

Rehearsal Assembly

Graduation rehearsal is on Monday 3rd December from 2:10 till 3:05. At this time it will be a demonstration of what happens on the night and explanation of how the whole evening will run.

Graduation

Graduation is on Wednesday the 5th of December at Campbell High School Hall. Arrivals will not be happening at the venue this year, instead, arrivals will be happening in the in the school car park between 4pm and 5:15pm. As we are using our school car park, this will be cleared from 3:05pm. Parking options for spectators will be available at the CSIRO carpark or War Memorial.

We kindly ask that if you are coming to watch the arrivals that spectators are on the hillside and follow the instruction of teachers to ensure an efficient and safe arrival process. Attached is a map of the areas for spectators. Photos will be made available to all year 10s and their families.

At 5:15 students will make their way down to our bus lines for a group photo with the War Memorial as the backdrop. Whilst this is happening parents are asked to file into the hall and await the arrival of the graduating year group. Formalities are predicted to commence at 5:30.

Students are going to sign for their year 10 certificates before stepping on stage. If students are not present for graduation, their year 10 certificate can be collected from the front office from midday Thursday until the end of the school year. A parent can sign for these on the student's behalf.

At 6:45, students will be ushered onto buses and transported to Ainslie football club for their formal. The bus is the only method of transport to the venue as arrivals and parking space during this time at the venue is limited.

Formal

Campbell High School has booked the upstairs function section of Ainslie football club. For the duration of the function (7-11), this area is booked exclusively for Campbell high school students and staff, with members of the general public not permitted. Staff will be stationed at the entry stairs to this area.

We understand that an 11pm finish may be a late finish for some. If at any time you wish to pick your child up before 11pm, come up the stairs to the function room where a staff member will gladly help. Alternatively, staff may make contact to parents/carers



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At the end of the formal (11pm) students will stay up in the function centre until collected, in person by a responsible adult from the function space. No student will be allowed to leave without a responsible adult.
