- Year 7 Language Conventions test – G line

Tuesday, 21st May:

- Year 7 Numeracy – B line
- Year 9 Numeracy – F line

All students must have a fully charged Chromebook and headphones throughout the testing period.

The purpose of the site is to familiarise students with the type of items they will see on NAPLAN Online and related functionalities.
