## Language students – Y 08 Y 09 Y 10

Bonjour and こんにちは Kon'nichiwa,

It is time to register for the Assessment of Language Competence (ALC). This year, ACER offers a listening test and reading test which can be purchased separately at \$10 each, or you may choose to do both tests to a cost of \$15 - and receive a printed certificate issued by ACER.

You need to register by the 29th of July COB for the school to be able to process your registration.

Each test takes about one hour (10 min to set up and 40 min for reading/40 min for listening). It is on-line and will give you immediate feedback. It will be given during class-time in August.

There are 3 different levels, ACER suggest that you choose depended on how many hours you have studied the target language by August in the year of testing:

- \* Certificate 1 for approximately 100 hours Year 8 (approx. 150 hours)
- \* Certificate 2 for approximately 200 hours Year 9 (approx. 250 hours)
- \* Certificate 3 for approximately 300 hours Year 10 (approx. 350 hours)
