During the October school holidays, technicians from Acer Computers will be at Campbell High School to undertake preventative maintenance on all of our student Chromebooks. Chromebooks will then be returned to students fully charged during Contact on the first day of term. All students must return their Chromebooks to the school prior to the end of term for this maintenance, regardless if they have been fixed recently or not.

On Friday the 27th of September all students must bring their Chromebook to school. Students will attend Contact for the first ten minutes of Enrichment to hand in their Chromebook. Enrichment and F line will be device free classes.

Students not attending school on Friday 27 September must hand their Chromebook in to the IT Officer (F12, in the Wellbeing Walkway) or the Library prior to leaving for the term.

All teachers understand that students will not have access to their Chromebooks for school work during the school holidays. Instead, students will be provided with a Challenge Card with device free challenges to complete over the holidays. At the beginning of Term 4, students can return their completed Challenge Card to Student Services to receive a merit.
