GRADUATION ASSEMBLY

The Graduation Assembly will be held at Campbell High School on Wednesday 5th of December 2018 from **5:15pm**. The assembly should be concluded by 6:30pm.

YEAR 10 FORMAL

The formal is to be held at Ainslie Football Club on Wednesday 5th of December 2018.

The formal will include a two course meal, drinks and entertainment. High school formals are a fantastic way for your child to celebrate their graduation from high school with their friends and teachers. I encourage your child to attend this right-of-passage event. The cost of the formal is **\$100**. This includes a copy of the "Highlander", the school yearbook. Full payment is required no later than one week prior to formal.

4:00pm – 5:00pm: Student arrivals at Campbell High School. Please note Mr Mackenzie will be taking photos of arrivals for students. These photos will be made available to students and their families after the event.

5:15pm: Families to move into hall for graduation. Year 10 whole year photo then move into the hall for graduation

5:30pm: Graduation commences in the hall.

6:45pm: Leave Campbell High School by bus to Ainslie Football Club.


7:00pm: Commence formal at Ainslie Football club function room

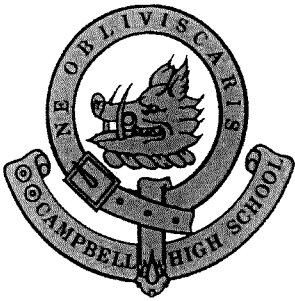
11:00pm: End of formal. Parents are asked to collect students promptly.

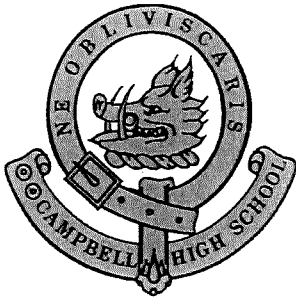

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YEAR 10 FORMAL PERMISSION NOTE
