As part of reconciliation week, the Warrumbul center will be taking students down to be part of the "Sorry Day" bridge walk to Parliament House. It will take place this Friday from 10am-2.30pm. We will be walking to and from the start and finish of the walk.

Each year National Sorry Day is commemorated across the country. Events publicly acknowledge and honour the stolen generations and are aimed at healing the hurts of the past. The first Sorry Day was held on 26 May 1998 one year after the tabling of the Bringing Them Home Report. The report was the result of the inquiry into the removal of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children from their families.

In Canberra, National Sorry Day is commemorated through the Sorry Day Bridge Walk, organised annually by Winnunga Nimmityjah Aboriginal Health Service. The march is being held on Friday 24 May, from 10:45AM at Regatta Point at the base of the Commonwealth Avenue Bridge.
