

Accessing Mt Ainslie Nature Reserve

Supervised by staff, students will walk to the designated starting point, use marked fire trials, have midway check points and designated finish point.



Reid Park (Ovals)

Supervised by staff, students will walk along the footpath crossing at the traffic lights on Limestone Avenue and Euree Street to get to Reid Ovals.



Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.
