CHS building good relationships with feeder schools.</p> <p>CHS has approval in principle for a pump track to be built at front of school. Aim is to start work next holidays. The track won't be fenced in. Kris taking lead.</p> <p>New lift approved in principle. Work will impact canteen access temporarily. Engineer report has been completed.
